BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S ORDINANCE NO. 2010-01**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE EAST CONTRA COSTA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT  
BOARD OF DIRECTORS APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE CONTRA COSTA  
COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT FIRE PREVENTION FEE SCHEDULE.**

**THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE EAST CONTRA COSTA FIRE PROTECTION  
DISTRICT DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I. Authority.** This ordinance is enacted, in part, pursuant to Health and Safety Code § 13910, 13146.2(b), 13217(b), 13869, 13871, 13916(a), 13916(b) and 17951, Government Code Section 6103.7 and Article 7 (§ 25120 et seq.).

**SECTION II. Notice and Hearing.** This ordinance was adopted pursuant to the procedures set forth in Government Code § 66016, 66017 and 66018, and Health and Safety Code § 13916. All required notices have been properly given and public hearings held.

**SECTION III. Reasonable Costs.** The Fire Prevention Fee Schedule has been reviewed and adopted by the Governing Board of the Contra Costa County Fire Protection District (as service provider) for the purpose of recovering reasonable costs to offset the expenses for the provision of providing services.

**SECTION IV. Fire Prevention Fees (Permit, Inspection, Plan Review and Other Fees).** Each person who applies for, requests, or receives a permit, inspection, plan review or other service furnished by the Contra Costa County Fire Protection District on behalf of the East Contra Costa Fire Protection District shall, at the time of application request or inspection, pay the applicable fee or fees listed in Exhibits "A and B" attached to this Ordinance. As used in this Section, the term "person" means any natural person, firm, association, joint venture, joint stock company, partnership, organization, club, company, corporation, trust or other type of entity. The Board of Directors, based on evidence within the record for its consideration of this matter, finds and determines that the fees on Exhibits "A and B" do not exceed the reasonable costs of providing the services for which the fees are charged.

**SECTION V. Severability.** If any fee or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, that holding shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining fees or provisions, and the Board declares that it would have adopted each part of this Ordinance irrespective of the validity of any other part.


**SECTION VI. Effective Date.** This ordinance becomes effective 30 days after passage. Within 15 days of passage, this ordinance shall be published once in a newspaper published within the region of the East Contra Costa Fire Protection District.
