- Definitions and details for each Fee can be found in the California Fire Code 2019 and ECCFPD Ordinance 2019-02 adopting the Fire Code with local amendments thereto, as each may be amended from time to time.
- Fees/recoverable costs for copies of documents and other records set forth in sections 10.1-10.5 are addressed in a separate policy on responses to Public Records Act requests and are subject to change from time to time in accordance with changes to the Public Records Act policy.
- Combination Permit Policy: Highest Permit Fee + 50% of each subsequent required permit.
- Inspection fees are based on \$293 per hour. Inspection and/or permit fees will be assessed at the time of the primary application.
- All inspection/permit fees include one (1) primary and one (1) re-inspection, unless otherwise noted.
- Occupancies requiring (3) or more inspections for compliance will be assessed an additional \$293 non-compliant fee for each inspection.
- Fees for Special Event services will be assessed at overtime rate for after-business-hours requests.
