285: Grants Policy

285.1 Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to guide District officials, staff and consultants in pursuing opportunities to secure grant funds to support District operations and address capital needs.

285.2 Policy: It is the policy of the District to attempt to obtain grants to support implementation of District goals and priorities while minimizing the need for the District to use other District revenues on such goals and priorities.

285.3 Delegation of authority: When applications for public and non-profit grants with individual values up to and including \$1 million can be submitted by the District without grant-specific Board resolutions, the Fire Chief is authorized to sign such grant applications. When public and non-profit grants of \$500,000 or less can be accepted by the District without grant-specific Board resolutions, and when such grants have District-funded matching requirements less than or equal to \$50,000, the Fire Chief is authorized to sign grant agreements and take any other actions necessary to accept such grants.

285.4 Reporting Requirement: The Fire Chief, or his designee, will report actions taken pursuant to the delegation of authority set forth in section 295.3 at the next regular Board of Directors meeting.
